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Obesity is a medical condition that affects approximately one-third of the adult population in the United States. It is a chronic disease that can increase the risk of developing other potentially life threatening conditions. Furthermore, the social and psychological effects of obesity can be catastrophic.

Losing weight through diet and exercise alone is optimal, however, it rarely works consistently for many severely overweight people. Weight loss surgery, or bariatric surgery, is the most effective method for long term weight-loss, but many patients resist having surgery. Innovative Bariatrics is able to offer a new incision-less, non-surgical option for weight loss, the Orbera Intra-gastric Balloon.



Orbera Weight Loss System

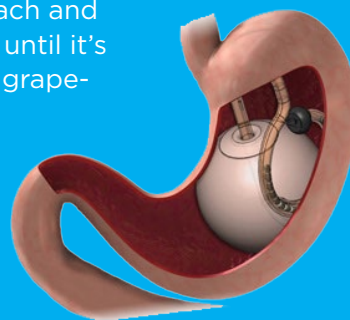
The Orbera Intra-gastric Balloon is a new incision-less, non-surgical option for weight loss. It bridges the gap between diet and exercise, pharmaceutical options and surgery — with great results. The placement of the intragastric balloon is for six months coupled with an individually tailored support program to help patients amplify their weight loss efforts to live a healthier lifestyle.

This FDA approved, non-surgical, reversible procedure is done under a mild sedative. The Orbera intragastric balloon is placed in the stomach and inflated with saline until it's about the size of a grape-fruit. The balloon is deflated and removed at six months, again under mild sedation.

It takes up space in the stomach to help patients eat smaller meals. Weight loss is rapid, with the majority of weight lost in the first 3 months.

Orbera with diet and exercise typically results in 3.1 times the weight loss than diet and exercise alone.

Surgical Solutions

Adjustable Gastric Band

This surgery helps people feel full faster and stay full longer. The procedure is adjustable and reversible. An adjustable silicone band is placed around the top of the stomach creating a small pouch approximately the size of an egg. This results in eating less food and the smaller stomach opening created by the band slows the emptying of food, thus causing the individual to feel full longer.

Gastric Bypass

A small stomach pouch is created near the top of the stomach and a portion of the intestines is brought up and connected to this pouch, bypassing the lower portion of the stomach and other parts of the digestive tract. The stomach pouch restricts food intake, while the bypass element decreases the absorption of glucose and fat.

Sleeve Gastrectomy

The stomach is divided and stapled vertically, creating a sleeve that can only hold a small volume of food. Approximately 85% of the stomach is removed.

It is a restrictive procedure with no malabsorption and no involvement of the intestines.

Since 2013 Sleeves have become the most common Bariatric procedures performed in the U.S.
